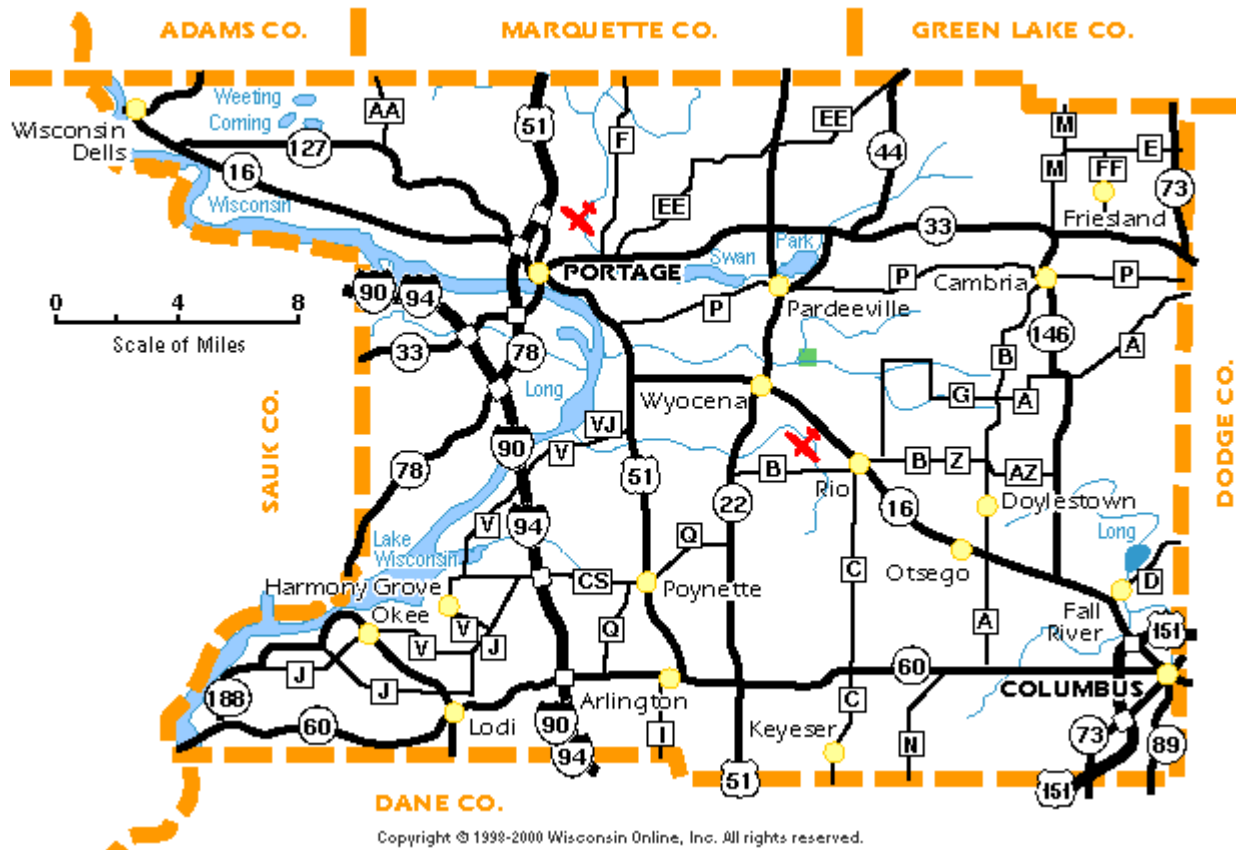
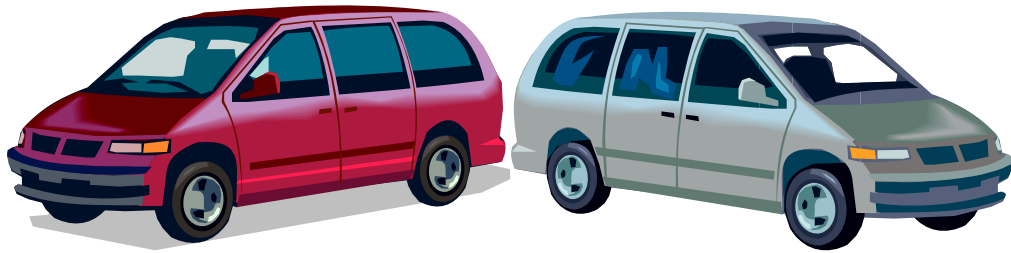

## **Locally Developed Transportation Coordination Plan**

### ***Purpose***

Federal transit law, as amended by SAFETEA-LU, requires that projects selected for funding under the Elderly Individuals and Individuals with Disabilities (Section 5310), Job Access and Reverse Commute (JARC)/Wisconsin Employment Transportation Assistance Program (WETAP), and New Freedom programs be “derived from a locally developed, coordinated public transit-human services transportation plan” and that the plan be “developed through a process that includes representatives of public, private, and non-profit transportation and human services providers and participation by members of the public.” This plan is intended to meet this requirement while providing guidance to the county and region in providing and improving specialized transportation services over the next five years.

This process will update the information compiled from the 2006 Columbia County coordination plan. The plan will concentrate on the effort to attend to transportation needs within Columbia County and to prioritize strategies to address this need.

### ***Process***

A county meeting, where a broad range of representatives from law enforcement, assisted living facilities, nursing homes, hospitals, clinics, churches, interested community members and Columbia County board and personnel, was held on February 27, 2009, with 13 persons in attendance.<sup>1</sup> The meeting was opened with a discussion of the SAFETEA-LU and WisDOT requirements for the plan along with grant opportunities that may be available. There was a discussion of demographics of the county, including elderly, disabled, and low-income persons, as well as their location and distribution throughout the county. Service gaps were then identified. A wide range of strategies for coordination of services were presented and the group provided input on the need for coordination, and developed strategies to pursue on a local level in the coming years. The final product, this document includes Columbia County’s goals and action items.

### ***Identified Gaps***

While assessing the transportation needs for individuals with disabilities, older adults and people with low incomes, the individuals at the meeting noted the following gaps in service.

- Lack of choices for low income individuals
- Affordable transportation services
- Individuals need cars/car loans
- Lodi and Wisconsin Dells need public transit
- County needs more accessible vehicles to station in specific areas throughout the county
- County Coordination Committee

- Coordinate trips between all providers to/from Madison
- Improve communication between transportation providers
- Develop a provider directory, with access to other providers as well as citizens
- Increase volunteer drivers
- Gain more knowledge about volunteer driver insurance
- Increase stakeholder participation (providers, consumers, companies, etc)
- Lack of transportation services for evenings and weekends
- Need for mass transit county wide
- Inter-county transit for medical appointments, shopping, employment
- Improved transportation services in Columbus
- Hire a mobility manager to assist with transportation gaps and needs
- Need low-income transport for the hours which they are employed  
(Fill in daytime down hours with medical transportation)
- Survey citizens to find out what their needs/wants really are
- Check into user side subsidies
- Coordination between counties

### *Actions and Strategies*

Two strategies with various actions were decided upon to help fill the gaps and needs identified.

- 1) Increase transportation funding in Columbia County.
  - A) Action: Apply for state and federal grants.
- 2) Increase transportation options for elderly, disabled and low-income citizens in Columbia County.

Actions:

- A) Create a Transportation Coordination Committee
- B) Improve communication through education
- C) Hire a mobility manager
- D) Survey county residence for gaps and needs in order to examine the possibility of public transit

In order to further work on the above strategies and actions, the director of Aging and Disability Resource Center of Columbia County, Christine See, will schedule another coordination meeting in April. The invitation list used for this meeting, the attendance list and additional stakeholders (companies, more citizens, etc) will be invited to discuss how to move forward with the above strategies and actions. From this meeting a Transportation Committee will be formed to meet on a bi-monthly basis. Timelines and roadblocks to implementation will be discussed through future meetings with the committee.

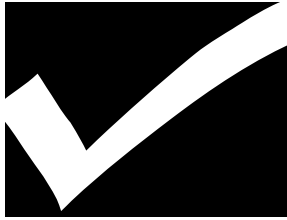

**Columbia County Transportation Coordination Planning Meeting Minutes**

February 27, 2009

Law Enforcement Center, Portage, WI

Facilitated by the Aging and Disability Resource Center of Columbia County

The meeting started with a general welcome and discussion of the agenda. Participants introduced themselves, what agency they were here to represent and what state or federal funds they utilized for transportation, if applicable.

The purpose for today's meeting along with the objective to write the 2009 Coordinated Transportation Plan was explained. We reviewed handouts while focusing on the Coordination Plan Worksheet to explain what the objectives of today's meetings were. Wisconsin Department of Transportation representatives, Bobbie Beson-Crone and David Lowe, reviewed funding options available to public and private entities.

Demographics of Columbia County's elderly, disabled and low-income populations were reviewed on three different maps. Locations of concentration were identified and discussed as to why these areas may have higher concentrations of particular populations.

A condensed list of count transportation services were handed out. The list was reviewed and several additions were made to the list that had not been previously identified.

After reviewing what is available for funding, current transportation options and demographics through Columbia County, attendees had an opportunity to brainstorm about the types of gaps and needs of these population groups as well as all citizens within the county.

Upon identifying a plethora of gaps and needs, the attendees narrowed down two strategies, with action items, that were broad in or to not limit work by the future committee.

While ending the meeting, attendees were asked to complete an evaluation to indicate if they felt the meeting was informative, helpful, etc and asking for their interest in participating on a committee to implement the strategies identified at this meeting.
