Item #3 – Needs: The Rock County Transportation Coordinating Committee identified the following transportation needs for the county:

- 1) Increased capacity for specialized transportation.

- 3) Increased funding to meet transportation needs.

Item #4 – Gaps: The Rock County Transportation Coordinating Committee identified the following gaps in transportation service for the county:

- 1) There are very limited evening and weekend transportation options for people who are elderly, disabled and/or low-income.
- 2) There are limited transportation options for grocery and nutrition-related transportation.
- 3) There is no public transportation for employment for late evening or early morning shifts.
- 4) There are limited options for low-income employees.
- 5) There are limited options for on-demand specialized transit.
- 6) Residential facilities with vehicles are not staffed to accommodate individual transportation needs for those clients needing supervision.
- 7) There is a lack of training for secondary school-age persons in how to use public transportation.
