This is the first public information meeting for the North 76th Street Project

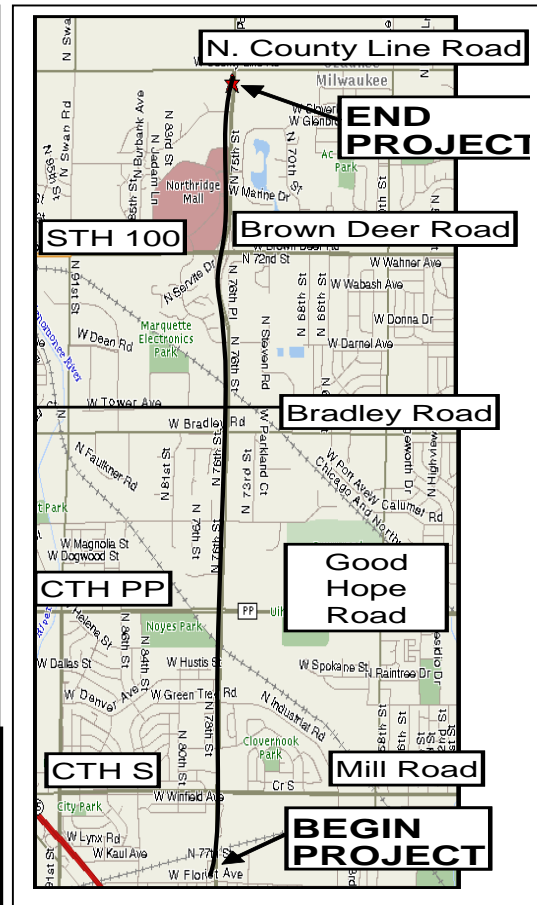

- Spring 2007: Begin construction

- November 2004 to August 2007: Design engineering
- Late 2006: Right-of-way acquisition
- Spring 2008: Begin construction

Did you know? Along this 4.5-mile segment of North 76th Street:

There are nearly 170 businesses, more than 30 apartment buildings, 129 driveways, 34 bus stops and 165 daily buses.

Traffic projections show more than 30,000 vehicles per day on North 76th south of Brown Deer Road.

North 76th Street (WIS 181) pavement replacement project

WisDOT plans to replace worn pavement, curbs and sidewalks along 4.5 miles of North 76th Street (WIS 181) in 2007-2008.

Construction cost is estimated at \$28 million.

Design details include:

- Removal and replacement of pavement, and addition of curb and gutters to retain the six-lane divided urban roadway.
- Improving turning movements, where possible at a number of intersections.
- Replacing drainage structures in curb lines to improve storm water removal.
- Replacing existing sidewalks that are in poor condition, and adding new sidewalks to improve pedestrian accommodations along the route. Assessments to property owners will be made on new sidewalk only at an estimated cost of \$3 per linear foot of walk.
- Replacing street lighting and traffic signals.
- Making minor repairs to most of the bridges along the route. The bridge over Brown Deer Road will receive a new deck.
