

Contingency Training

Course Description:

This 120- hour program is designed to provide Wisconsin law enforcement certification to patrol officers who were previously certified in another state or officers who were certified in Wisconsin and had a break in their law enforcement service. The focus is on knowledge and skills at a level required of experienced patrol officers.

Pre-Requisite:

Must be currently employed by a Wisconsin law enforcement agency and must have been previously certified as a law enforcement officer. The Wisconsin Department of Justice, Training and Standards Bureau must approve attendance.
