

Pursuit Intervention Technique

Course Description:

This training program has been designed to provide the officer with the special knowledge and skills necessary to successfully perform the Pursuit Intervention Technique (PIT). In addition to first time students this course is also open to students with prior PIT training as a refresher in the technique. Students will receive classroom and practical hands-on training in the proper execution of this Intervention Option including conducting several actual PIT maneuvers.
