

Reid Advanced Interview and Interrogation

The advanced program is designed to build on the information learned at the basic program. Particular emphasis is placed on how to elicit information from the suspect during the interview stage that will serve as the basis for developing an individualized interrogational approach, based on the suspect's profile and characteristics.

The Reid Basic Interview and Interrogation 3-day course.
